The Cleveland Orchestra adds *Elf in Concert* and *The Princess Bride* to 2023–24 Severance season

CLEVELAND – Additions to The Cleveland Orchestra's 2023–24 Severance season will have you singing "Christmas Time is Here" during the month of July. The Cleveland Orchestra announced on Monday more movies and more ways to celebrate the holidays.

Elf in Concert, featuring the 2003 film on the big screen with live orchestral accompaniment, is sure to delight audiences at Severance Music Center on December 19 and 20. On February 16, experience *The Princess Bride* like you've never seen before with The Cleveland Orchestra performing the entire musical score live-to-picture. These films are in addition to the previously announced classical season concerts of the Academy Award–winning *Amadeus Live* on September 21, 22, 23, and 24 with The Cleveland Orchestra Chorus.

Jazz pianist Cyrus Chestnut will come to Severance Music Center on December 8 to perform from his 2000 album *A Charlie Brown Christmas*. One of the most acclaimed jazz artists of our time puts his own touch on Vince Guaraldi's music written for the iconic 1965 animated television special of the same name.

The fun continues in December with The Cleveland Orchestra Holiday Concerts, featuring conductor Brett Mitchell, singer Capathia Jenkins, and The Cleveland Orchestra Chorus. There are 12 performances, including a just-added matinee on Friday, December 22.

Presale tickets for *Amadeus Live*, Cyrus Chestnut & Friends: *A Charlie Brown Christmas*, *Elf in Concert*, and *The Princess Bride* are available for donors, subscribers, and past movie buyers starting July 10 at 10 a.m. Sales to the general public start July 17.
